Please use caution with people who are released/on supervised release. Recently an inmate on work release had cut off her monitor bracelet and called for a ride. Transporting an inmate on the run is breaking the law and would put future AA meetings at the jail at risk. One suggestion is to ask the inmate if they're on the run.

They meet on Wed at 6:30pm and the meetings last until 8 or 8:30pm. The NA groups only come in twice a month so the inmates really appreciate having weekly AA meetings. Both the men and women really appreciate all of the AA literature that the district and others have donated. So thank you to everyone who's participated directly and indirectly through you meeting donations to the groups that do donate to the district. Inmates can have one on one visitors from the AA community.

Men's Corrections - No report. Last month Brandon reported that the Wed 6:30pm men's group meetings are 15-20 each. The inmates look forward to the meetings and they're well behaved and generally interested in recovery with good emotional discussions. The 2 meetings last 2-3 hrs total. A few more people got cleared to help with the meetings. If you'd like to get and out of jail this is your chance!
